



AAAPP HURRICANE RESILIENCY PROGRAM

FUNDING IS AVAILABLE TO ASSIST PINELLAS AND PASCO COUNTY SENIORS IMPACTED BY HURRICANE HELENE AND/OR MILTON

The AAAPP Senior Community Health is providing Care Coordination and services to hurricane impacted seniors who qualify.

To qualify for assistance, the client must:

- Be age 60+ and have a hurricane related crisis need based on impacts from Hurricanes Helene and/or Milton
- Be financially eligible based on SSI Related programs standards for ICP (Nursing home Medicaid), HCBS, (Home and Community Based Services), Hospice. **flexible based on hurricane related crisis needs.*
- Be a resident of Pasco or Pinellas County. *Clients temporarily residing in another county may be considered for assistance if they are returning to Pasco or Pinellas County.*
- Be living at home (not in a facility such as Assisted Living or Skilled Nursing).
- Not enrolled in a Medicaid Waiver Funded Long Term Care program such as PACE or SMMC LTC.

Assistance may include:

- completion of the AAAPP Disaster Rapid Needs Assessment to determine disaster related needs
- assistance with FEMA applications
- resource navigation and coordination
- financial assistance for overdue rent/mortgage due to storm related expenses
- financial assistance for overdue utilities
- one-time payment of storage unit fees to retrieve items
- replacement of medical equipment
- move in costs such as security deposits / pet deposits
- replacement of essential household items
- consumable medical supplies such as pull-ups and nutritional shakes
- pet food and supplies

Assistance does not include:

- housing or placement **housing resources will be provided through the AAAPP Helpline.*
- moving client's belongings to new location
- items that are covered under client's insurance
- reimbursement for services already rendered and paid
